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Why learn about medication safety?



Almost 15% of college students say they misuse prescription stimulants. (Ohio State University, 2022)

28% of College students report it is easy to obtain prescription stimulants on campus. (Ohio State University, 2022)

A surge that began in 2018 has led to a nearly 3-fold increase in deaths among older adolescents due to fentanyl. (JAMA Pediatrics, 2023)
